

KING'S CROSS, GASWORKS TUNNEL

LOCATION King's Cross, Gasworks Tunnel – East Bore, London, England

Outside of the train station King's Cross in London there are 3 tunnels, the so-called Gasworks
Tunnels. The east bore of these tunnels was closed for several decades and not available for railway

services. This tunnel was re-activated and open for public rail services. The railway tracks used in this tunnel is a slab track of the system Slab Track Austria (STA). Despite this, the crossovers were built in the track system LVT Standard. Outside of the portals of the tunnel transitions to the ballasted tracks

are located.
